This Operations Directive is for internal use only and does not enhance an officer's civil or criminal liability in any way. It should not be construed as a creation of a higher standard of safety or care in an evidentiary sense, with respect to third party claims. Violations of this Operations Directive, if proven, may only form the basis for a complaint by this Department, and only in a non-judicial administrative setting.

SECTION 1 PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to require that all Field Training Officers conduct a review of the Field Training Program processes on schedule as determined by the Field Training Coordinator.

SECTION 2 POLICY

It is the policy of the Department that all Field Training Officers conduct a review of the Field Training Program processes annually.

SECTION 3 PROCEDURES

A. The Field Training Coordinator will schedule a meeting annually with all Field Training Officers to discuss the processes and effectiveness of the Department's Field Training Program. Field Training Officers should consider any problems with the Field Training Program and make recommendations to ensure the program's success. The annual meeting must be documented, and the Field Training Coordinator must keep the documentation for future reference as any necessary changes are made to enhance the Field Training Program.

B. RESPONSIBILITY

1. All members of the Department shall know and comply with all aspects of this directive.
2. All Division Commanders and supervisory personnel are responsible for ensuring compliance with the provisions and intent of this directive.
